other residents are in the background of the picture or video that could potentially lead to a violation of their privacy. We ask you to help us protect our residents and yourself from violating any privacy rules that potentially could result in unfavorable outcomes. Roxie's Recipe - Roasted Mexican Zucchini

INGREDIENTS

3-4 medium zucchini, diced
2 tablespoons olive oil
½ teaspoon chili powder
½ teaspoon garlic powder
½ teaspoon cayenne pepper
salt and pepper, to taste
Crumbled cotija cheese, lime juice,
and/or fresh cilantro, for garnish

(optional, but highly recommended)

DIRECTIONS

- Preheat oven to 425 degrees F and line a rimmed baking sheet with parchment paper.
- In a medium bowl, mix zucchini, olive oil, chili powder, garlic powder, cayenne pepper, and salt/pepper until well coated.
- Spread evenly on baking sheet and roast for 25 minutes, or until zucchini is browned.
- 4. Serve sprinkled with lime juice, cotija cheese, and chopped fresh cilantro, if desired.

- Never say "you can't", Instead say what they Can Do
- Never Demand, Instead Ask
- Never Condescend, Instead Encourage
- Never Force, instead Reinforce

WHEN IT'S TIME

Some residents come to the Friendship Home because they have had a medical issue and have been in the hospital, some because the family feels they are not safe at home and some because home health care is not enough at the time. Whatever the reason, it is an adjustment for the loved one as well as the family. Many families are relieved to know someone is caring for their loved one 24 hours a day.

Sometimes families get very lucky and their loved one announces that they want to go to a nursing home. The family doesn't feel guilty because it is the loved ones decision. Sometimes the adjustment period doesn't go so easily, the loved one is upset that they had to move and the families feel guilty. There may be a period where the loved one is not easy to come visit. They may blame the family for the situation or complain about the nursing home and fail to find anything positive. This usually resolves over time and things will get better. Everyone responds to change differently and the Friendship Home staff is prepared to help with the adjustment and acceptance of the situation.

FLU SHOTS

The "flu" season is fast approaching. The seasonal influenza is caused by a virus that infects the respiratory tract. Unlike other viral respiratory infections, like the common cold, influenza can cause severe illness and life-threatening complications in many people, especially the elderly. The best way to prevent influenza is by getting vaccinated each year. Influenza vaccines protect against the most likely forecasted strains of the virus that change every year. Everyone 6 months and older should get vaccinated annually unless medically contraindicated. I will be sending out educational material along with consents for our residents in the next several weeks. Please be on the lookout for these and return as soon as possible.
